### What is Our Vision for The Future?

(Excerpted from 19<sup>th</sup> St. Baptist Church, Washington, DC)

Let us direct our focus to ACTS 2:41-47. This is the vision God sets forth for His church. This is the very first description of the Church after Pentecost in Jerusalem. Acts 2:41 - 47:- *Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.*

### AFTER THE 40 DAYS

The Lord empowers us to destroy the strongholds of the enemy after we have fasted and prayed prevailing prayers. It brings upon the believer, great revival and a renewed spirit.

Most times when we receive instructions through spiritual leaders or even when we feel that deep sense of urgency or need to fast, we questioned whether "it is truly God's instruction or call for us." And when we do convince ourselves that it is the call of God to fast, we begin to process in our minds, that this may be the answer to our own personal need or problem. We, most times, do not include God's purpose or reason.

God did call us to fast. Because He did so with a specific reason or purpose, we began the fast with excitement and expectancy. But what were you expecting? Is it only your own personal need or breakthrough? Did you forget who instructed you or why you were instructed to fast? God's most important reason for instructing you to fast and pray (not the only reason) is the need for the fulfillment of the Great Commission.

What is the Great Commission? The Great Commission is found in Matthew 28:18-20 (Where on a mountain in Galilee Jesus calls on his followers to baptize all nations in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.)- *Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and*

*make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

Forty days is a long time to go without solid food. But with each passing day, His call grows stronger and clearer. Your faith and your confidence are in the Lord to help you with each step. Each day His presence encouraged us to continue. The longer you fasted, the more you sensed the presence of the Lord. Your soul and your spirit are refreshed, and so you experience the joy of the Lord more than ever before.

Now that we have ended 40 days of fasting and praying, I pray that the Holy Spirit has visited with you in the spirit of 2 Chronicles 7:14 (*If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.*) so that you can fulfill the great Commission.

I pray that you stay in His presence so that you will begin to reap the benefits.

In **Fellowship** we look toward one another as the Body of Christ.

**A Vision for Worship** - Colossians 2:10  
Worship defines us... Everything we do as a ministry is validated by the fact that we worship God. We will be revitalized and strengthened as we understand that our worship of the Father must be Spirit led, and Christ centered.

**A Vision for Discipleship** - John 14:12-14  
Discipleship is the call beyond "comfortable Christianity." Every bold and significant action of the church occurs when men and women genuinely, actively, seek to be like Jesus. A church is blessed and empowered when discipleship is a central purpose and value.

**A Vision for Ministry** - Ephesians 2:10  
Every Christian is called to Ministry ... *For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.*

**A Vision For Stewardship** - 2 Corin 9:7  
Stewardship is always about relationship... Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

While we are no longer under the weight of the Law, the tithe is the Biblical model that God has promised to honor.

# PEACE

All scripture references are from the King James Version.
