THE POWER OF LOVE

There is an epidemic of hate in the world today. Look around you. Neighbors against neighbors; family against family; children against children; wars, people killing each other, suicide bombers, hit lists, etc. What is going on? Where is the love? Hate is growing more rampant. What is the world coming to? Where is the love? Where is God's love? The problem of hate distorts humanity, changes our thought processes and calls good evil and evil good.

The Bible teaches us how to love one another; to connect to the One who is love, the One who said that "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends." and followed it up with action. God, by definition IS "love."

In order for us to experience the power of love, we must do away with hatred for another. The Bible tells us in 1 John 2:11 (KJV) - "But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes."

Hate is not to be taken lightly. Hate can easily find expression in us, if we listen to our emotions more than we do Christ. What does Christ say? He says something even more challenging than what we are looking at today - Jesus says, "Love your enemies". This is Jesus' call to us to love one another. This is love within the church, between sisters and brothers. Whoever loves his brother lives in the light..

Let me distinguish between the power of love and the power of hate.

a) The Power of Love gives light and clarity. When we love, we very often will look at life and at others with more understanding. Love listens. It doesn't assume, it knows.

b) Hate is closed, mind-made-up, judgment made. Hate envies. Hate keeps close tabs on the behavior of others. Hate is self-seeking. Hate loves to see harm come to others.

But Scripture tells us in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 that "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails."

God is the POWER behind love. That is why love is all these things.

Love heals divisions. Love asks for forgiveness. Love gives forgiveness. Love reaches out, touches the lives of others and is itself nourished as it reaches out.

The love of God is the true love that stands as the eternal standard and definition of what love is and means. GOD IS LOVE. And, as the scripture says, we love because He first loved us!

"Love ever gives. Forgives, outlives; and ever stands with open hands. And while it lives, it gives, for this is love's prerogative - to give, and give, and give". - John Oxenham

Let us pray that our Father God will teach us to love like He loves us; that He will teach us to love one another through actions and not only words; that He will teach us to love our enemies; that He will help us to rise to that challenge of loving our enemies; that He will help us show love in our daily lives.

There is none other commandment greater than these.
