But He gives a greater grace. Therefore it says, "God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble." - James 4:6 (ASB)

Grace always establishes us in the steadfastness of God. In order to be greater believers we will need "Greater Grace" from God. This greater grace that will allow you to become a greater believer and thus a greater church include:

1. Being a humble servant. It's not about you; it's all about Christ. We need to make a conscious decision to submit to the rule of Christ in our lives. Rom 12:1 (ISV)- *I therefore urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercies, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices that are holy and pleasing to God, for this is the reasonable way for you to worship..*

2. Put on the armor of God and advance to the frontline and fight the devil. 2 Corinthians 10:3-4- *For though we walk*

in the flesh, we do not wage war according to the flesh. The weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of strongholds.

If we put up an active, ongoing resistance, the devil will flee. And if we refuse to fight, he will continue to hold us captive.

3. Develop a closer relationship with God. Acknowledge and give honor to God. Glorify God always. Ps 145:18- *The LORD is near to all who call upon Him in truth.*

Resolutions or Affirmations

It's a new year; and with the New Year, comes new resolutions or new goals; forcing us to make a firm decision to DO or NOT DO for the year ahead. Why RESOLUTIONS? Why not AFFIRMATIONS?

The first to point out here is that resolutions are notorious for being broken. Affirmations can actually change our beliefs and bring a greater awareness to what we are creating in our lives. (eg. affirmations like, affirmative prayer. Affirmations focus on the spirit realm, whereas resolutions tend to be focused on the worldly realm. And we all know that worldly focus are usually not followed through; thus resolutions.

How do we create our affirmations for the New Year?

1. Try to figure out where in your life you need change. Write it down. Now write biblical instructions or statements to support the area of desired change and the type of change you are seeking. Be sure to speak positively regarding the aspect and type of change; affirming what you DO want to happen, not what you hope to prevent.

For example:

AFFIRMATION: "I experience divine order in every area of my life,"

RESOLUTION: "I will not allow my desk and closet to get messy."

2. Speak your affirmations daily.

These affirmations will rearrange and redirect your thoughts in a conscious, positive direction and destroy the negative beliefs we hold about ourselves and our lives. Use affirmations daily until they become your experience. †

JANUARY PRAYER FOCUS

A New Beginning!

Following are some of the daily prayer focus, taken from the book *'Awakening'* by Stovall Weems, please pray in agreement with all who will be fasting and praying:

- Prepare your heart to hear the voice of God, and ask Him to help you remove distractions so that you can focus on Him and hear His voice clearly;
 - For increase in level of faith to believe that 'nothing is impossible' for you;
 - Walk in agreement with God and enjoy the life He desires you to have in Christ;
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will help you see God through the eyes of grace and truth given to us in Jesus Christ;
 - Yield to the Holy Spirit and lean on His strength to overcome obstacles of sin and selfishness in your life;
 - Pray Psalm 51;
 - Seek a fresh revelation of who God is in your life;
 - Pray the Lord's prayer;
 - Pray for family and friends who do not know God; pray specifically for areas of life to be changed;
 - Ask for the spirit of humility for yourself before the Lord each day and bring your cares to Him;
 - Ask for help in areas of disappointment and discouragement;
 - Recapture all worried thought and send it to God as a prayer;
 - Invite God to fill you with His power and all spiritual resources He has for you;
 - Pray that the Lord will expand your life to glorify Him, giving you boldness to step out and be used by Him;
 - Pray that God continually reveals His purpose and gives you ever-increasing clarity and strength to walk it out.
- May our passion and love for Jesus be re-awakened and reignited, that we may serve Him whole-heartedly. Romans 12:11†*
