Paul writes in Colossians 3:1-3:- *"If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God."*

Walk in Newness of Life

Easter is the time when we commemorate the death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He died on the cross for our sins and rose the third day fulfilling The scripture as it is written in Matthew 8:17 - *That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses;* and according to Isaiah 53:5, *by His stripes we are healed* . It is ONLY by His grace that we are saved (Eph.2:5). We have renewal of life because of Christ's Death and Resurrection.

Many of us see this time as a time to clean our closets and our homes, re-arrange things, and attend Church services to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Symbolically, we can view Easter as a time of resurrecting from our old nature, a time to reflect, initiate change, and take action.

As we celebrate Easter, I encourage you to reflect on Jesus' sacrifice on Mount Calvary. Begin to initiate peace, love, and hope by allowing God to change you into the person He has called you to be - His servant in His vineyard. And because we do this, He will order our steps and we can continuously praise Him for His greatness in our lives.

When we walk in newness of life, we have a new level of confidence, which enables us to let go of our past and look to our future. Our old nature, filled with doubts, fears, insecurities, sadness, rebellion and un-forgiveness is replaced with our new nature - modeled after Jesus, in which peace, joy, and love reign. We have peace in knowing that Jesus is taking care of all of our problems and that we can rest from our grief and toils. We have joy in knowing that we have salvation because of the shed blood of Christ. We have unconditional love from God, who has forgiven us of all of our sins, and is always waiting to receive us with open arms.
