STIR UP YOUR GIFT!

Do you desire to be in God's WILL? Are you attempting to overcome the deeds of the flesh so that you can live your life free from sin and stir up the gift of the Holy Spirit that lies dormant in you? Do you know what the Holy Spirit has for you?

God does NOT desire for us to let the gift of the Holy Spirit that he has given us to lie dormant in our lives. 1st Timothy 4:11 tells us to, "Neglect NOT the gift that is IN you which was given you by prophecy with the laying on of hands of the presbytery."

2nd Timothy 1:6, 7 tells us this same truth in a slightly different way. "Wherefore I put you in remembrance that you STIR UP the gift of God, which is IN you by the putting on of my hands. For God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power and of love, and of a sound mind."

Stir up Your Gift

When we stir up the gift of the Holy Spirit, as given to us by God, we gain strength sufficient to overcome the world.

Paul's words to Timothy were intended to keep the young evangelist from becoming sluggish in the service of God. When the fire burns low in you, the spirits of fear and shame, mentioned here by Paul, are more easily felt.

Do you know how to "stir up" this gift of God (Holy Ghost fire) that is in you? Do you know how to let the power of God be manifested through you? If you are anxious to "stir up" the gift of God which is in you, and recover your lost fellowship with God, then here is what you need to do:

1) **REPENT:** *"Remember from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works. . . ."* –Rev 2:5 *"He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment, and I will not blot out his name out of the Book of Life"*– Rev 3:5

2) **PRAY** until you attain a willing mind. Pray without ceasing until you are restored. Prayer is the paddle we use to "stir up" the gift of God. Pray until you feel the effects of it. Put yourself in a condition to serve God and gain eternal life.

"Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth," as Paul warn you in Ephesians 4:29-32, *"but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it might minister grace unto the hearers; and grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamor, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice. And be ye kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you."* †
