Regardless of what you are going through, know that God is in control. Know that His blessings are upon you. Know that if He brought you to it, He will see you through it. Look at your situation with a new perspective and a positive attitude and give God the praise because He dwells in the midst of our praise!

Be Thankful for the Blessing!

Proverbs 10:22 (KJV) - *The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.*

In this scripture, David was saying, "God when I see your awesome power through which You have made the heavens, I don't understand why that you would pay attention to mankind. Yet, it is evident that you have blessed and surrounded mankind with great glory and honor.

Not only was David one to recognize the blessing of God, but he also was one that didn't forget the blessing of God upon his life.

In the early life of David, before he was king, the Bible tells us that Saul tried to harm David and destroy his kingly ministry. However, it tells us a different story about a man named Jonathan by whom came God's kindness and blessing upon the life of David. Now as we read the story let's remember that it was actually God that was blessing David through the life of Jonathon.

The bible declares that we try God's patience when we forget the blessings of God.
